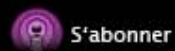

J.B. "...I'm Jane. B, Editor of NY Times radio ; today I'm talking to Ed Andrews in Washington about Federal Reserve Chairman Ben Bernanke's appearance before the House Budget Committee ; while declining to say that the economy was heading into a recession any time soon, he did support quick passage of an economic stimulus package in Congress.

BEN BERNANKE: "To be useful, a fiscal stimulus package should be implemented quickly, and structured so its effect on aggregate spending are felt as much as possible within the next twelve months."

J.B. Ed, thanks for talking to me today. Is the question of whether we're in a recession or almost in a recession or not quite in a recession quibbling over semantics now? I mean how important is that particular definition?

Ed Andrews: "Well that's a really good question; on one level, it's not at all important, because things can feel pretty awful even when you're not in a recession, if you're pretty close to one; in fact it's helpful to remember that in the last recession in 2001, unemployment continued to decline for about 2 years after the recession officially ended so, er, things are feeling a lot worse actually for a lot of people long after the recession is over, when we're supposedly in a recovery, but it is important in another sense, if the economy is actually contracting, that's a trend that's very alarming and you want to stop as soon as you possibly can."

Immigration Bill Stalled in US Senate

Bipartisan Immigration Bill Stalls in Senate

Robert Siegel: The sweeping bill aimed at revamping the country's immigration laws has apparently stalled in the US Senate. Senators tonight refused to limit debate on the compromise bill that was reached by a bipartisan group of senators and the White House. NPR's Brian Naylor is on Capitol Hill and he joins us now, and Brian I want you to explain to us what happened to the immigration bill this evening.

Brian Naylor : Well, they had a procedural vote to limit, to end debate on this bill – they've been debating it for about two weeks now, and the Senate majority leader Harry Reid said it was time to bring this debate to a close ; they needed 60 votes in order to end the debate, but they only got less than a majority, 45 or so, and so they didn't get a majority, they didn't get the 60 votes, they can't end debate, and so Senator Reid announced that he was moving on to something else, it was time to wrap up the immigration bill and move on to the energy bill.

The Jena 6

NPR News, September 21, 2007

NPR: President Bush has said he was saddened by the events in Jena, Louisiana, that led up to yesterday's demonstrations ; **thousands of people from across the country protested to show support for the so-called Jena 6.** The name refers to a group of black teenagers accused of beating a white classmate. The boys were initially facing charges of attempted murder (*tentative de meurtre*) for the brawl (*bagarre*). Prosecutors (*littéralement, procureurs, ici représentants de l'accusation*) say they are fighting for a forgotten victim, but civil right protesters argue Jena School and **Law Enforcement officials are dealing out harsher charges to the African-American teenagers** than their white counterparts. At the rally (*la démonstration to support the Jena 6 on September 20*) was NPR's Artie Comish:

- Nécessité d'une mutualisation des ressources et des matériels élaborés entre enseignants
- Flexibilité, évolution constante de l'univers des TIC = une dimension dynamique, stimulante pour l'enseignant
